## Instructions for Locating a Comprehensive Summary of U.S. Embargoes and Sanctions in Visual Compliance

MIT has a university-wide license to a program called [Visual Compliance](#) that faculty and staff use to perform [Restricted Party Screening](#). Restricted Party Screening allows people within the MIT domain to determine whether U.S. government sanctions, embargoes, and prohibitions on foreign countries and foreign nationals prevent MIT from engaging with certain parties.
